Garden Development Project.

It is with great excitement that we can say that work on the school garden will be happening soon in the shape of a 500 metre path providing infrastructure for the design, and access for the children to the grounds at the rear of the school. We are currently talking to potential contractors for the work but would like to know if there is anyone within our school community positioned to complete the task. This entails: cutting 500m of trenches 15cm deep, laying and whacking 100 tons of gravel (approx. 1250 wheelbarrow loads), excavating a 20m long x 22m wide x .30m deep bog garden, digging 13 x .65m x .65m holes for the orchard trees, levelling a 10m diameter disc for the living willow dome and cutting an 8m trench through an existing mound approx. 2m deep to form a fern garden. All waste soil will be used to create 3 or 4 mounds for the children to clamber on and over. Machinery, insurance and labour must be included in any proposed undertaking of the works.
